EDCO : What is it?

- Informal consortium of organizations who operate large data centers
 - **THIS IS NOT AN OFFICIAL IETF ACTIVITY**
 - Core group includes: financials, Internet-based companies, U.S. government agencies
 - First meeting at IETF98 in Chicago (end of March)
 - Boot camp (volunteer organized)

EDCO : Why was it formed?

- TLS1.3 issue
- Over 100 groups at the IETF, no one organization can monitor them all
- Many areas in an organization affected: security (infrastructure, voice), routing, architecture (IPv6)

EDCO : What will it do?

- Discuss protocol changes with participants
- Collaborate
- Bring point of view of enterprises to the IETF
- Enterprises are not used to going to the IETF: IETF is not used to enterprises
- Can attend as an individual

EDCO : What is the future?

- In-person attendance at IETF best, but not always possible
- Form trade organization
- Subscription to report with reviews of WG
- Webcasts to discuss report / protocol changes
