- At the IETF standards for the Internet are developed
- Aims of fellowship programme
 - Raise global awareness of the IETF
 - Allow for better understanding and participation by technical experts from developing countries
 - Provide opportunity for engineers around the world to meet people working in the same field
 - Foster cooperation and collaboration
- First pilot in May 2006

 - Preparing the fellow before the meeting
 - Helping the fellow during the meeting (chose WG mtgs. to attend, introduce to people etc.)
- Fellows mailing list
 - Follow-up from time to time (Alumni network)
- Evaluation forms for fellows & mentors
- Must engage in "experience sharing" project on returning to home country
